

# HHUC Advanced Diver Course

## Overview

The HHUC Advanced Diver course will provide divers, who have already completed a Scuba Diver certification, with additional skills in buoyancy, navigation, rescues and dive computers. Additionally, we will explore diving in different environments, including managing the challenges associated with deep diving, night diving, cold water diving and current diving.

## Schedule

### 1. Classroom session at Hart House

Date: June 22, 2017 – 7pm-10:00pm

### 2. Barrie Shore Dive

Date: July 8, 2017

Activity: Shore Diving; Navigation Dive; Surface Rescue

### 3. Rockport/Brockville Boat Dive

Date: August 5, 6, 7

Activity: Boat Diving; Dive Computer Use; Night Dive; Deep Dive; Current Diving

**NOTE 1:** You will be diving in United States waters for certain dives. You must have documentation that permits entry to the USA.

**NOTE 2:** The Hart House travel policy is in effect this trip. All UofT students must travel from Toronto to and from Brockville by professionally driven transportation (mega bus, train, etc ...) ## Fees:

**Course registration fees:** \$155+HST (HHUC members), \$275 +OUC insurance (non-members). On-line course registration available until July 6<sup>th</sup>, 2017. Fee is non-refundable unless authorized by the organizer, and subject to a \$25 cancellation fee. Includes NAUI materials and supervised instruction.

**Boat dive fees:** approximate: \$75 per day (HHUC members), and \$100 per day (non-members).

**Full scuba gear:** Advanced students are responsible for full scuba gear on each dive at your own cost. Weekly/summer gear rentals are available for HHUC members (see HHUC website).

**Travel and Accommodation:** Advanced students are responsible for the travel and accommodation costs during the course.
