



NAUI Advanced Scuba Diver Course

Continue your diving education with the Hart House Underwater Club!

Are you recently certified? Has it been a long time since you have been diving? Do you want to improve your scuba skills in a variety of environments with some direction? The Advanced Scuba Diver Course is just what you are looking for.

This course is open to **all** certified divers. The course allows you to add new skills in a controlled, supervised environment. You will be introduced to a variety of diving activities in an open water setting.

A minimum of six open water dives are required to complete this course.

- Required dives: navigation, night diving, and deep diving.
- Suggested elective dives: wreck diving, current diving, and dive computer use.

Payment Schedule

Installment 1: \$150 + HST due July 4, 2016 – Registration Deadline

Installment 2: \$350 + HST due July 20, 2016

Course fee of \$500 + HST includes transportation, accommodation, and boat fees for one of the two boat diving weekends. This does not include scuba diving equipment rental.

Course fees are non-refundable except in the case of medical contraindications to diving. If you are uncertain whether you have a medical contraindication to diving, please reach out to the instructor before payment and registration.
