### Interdisciplinary Capacity Enhancement Team Request for Support for Proposal Development

### The objectives of the HCTP "ICE" grant are to nurture:

- (a) *scientific achievement* by equipping researchers from diverse disciplines to generate methods, concepts, and theories for understanding and strengthening the new networks of contemporary health care;
- (b) research capacity enhancement by positioning HCTP researchers to compete successfully for research funding and by creating collaborative research opportunities for investigators new to the health research community;
- (c) multi-sectoral knowledge translation by involving decision-makers from industry, government, and health care agencies in research and training processes
- (d) *interdisciplinary and inter-institutional mentorship and networking* through linkages with the HCTP Strategic Training Program.

#### **Information and Instructions:**

To function as a nimble and dynamic research catalyst, the HCTP Request for Support process must be swift and non-burdensome for researchers, while remaining objective and accountable.

- 1. Average support allocations are anticipated to be \$2500.00 per proposal. Maximum support provided to a single proposal will be \$4500.00 An itemized budget is required for all Requests.
- Requests will be reviewed by HCTP Co-Directors throughout the year. There is no deadline for submission, and requests generated outside the October 2003 workshop are eligible. Normally requests will be reviewed within 5-10 days of receipt, with results conveyed by email.
- 3. HCTP-supported proposals must address one or more HCTP ICE themes (for details, consult the ICE grant proposal):

Human Bodies in the New Health Care/Improving Quality
Health Care Places/Public Advice Seeking in an Era of eHealth
Technologies in the New Health Care/ Evaluation & Technology
New Health Care Work/Health Human Resources

- 4. HCTP-supported grant proposals must be developed collaboratively by interdisciplinary teams. Doctoral and Post-Doctoral Fellows may participate on HCTP grant writing teams.
- 5. HCTP should be acknowledged in supported proposals and funded research as follows: Development of this proposal/research was supported by "Health Care, Technology, and Place: An Interdisciplinary Capacity Enhancement Team grant" from the Institute of Health Services and Policy Research, CIHR.
- 6. Funding results for HCTP-supported proposals must be reported for program evaluation purposes.
