



## **Montreal biotech invention**

29 firms in Montreal have 234 locally invented patents Out of which

The four largest have 175 patents (75%)
The eight largest have 209 patents (89%)
21 other have 25 patents
(In 1998 only 14 firms had 66 patents in all)
4 universities and 1 government labs with patents




