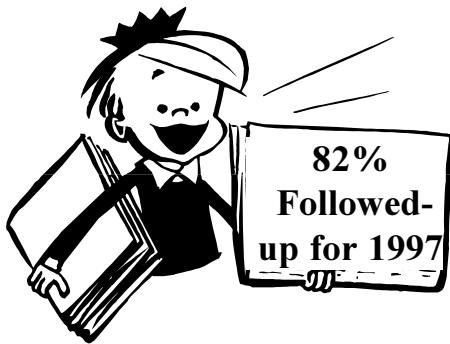

Trial Co-ordination:

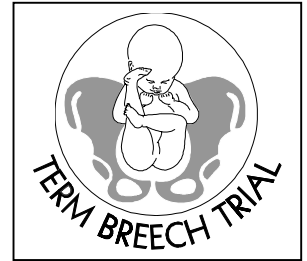
