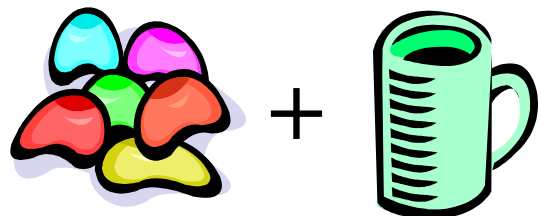
## TBT: 2 year Follow-up Rates

... A TBT mug filled with *Jelly Belly™ jellybeans* will be awarded to every centre reaching an 80% follow-up rate for babies born in 1999!!

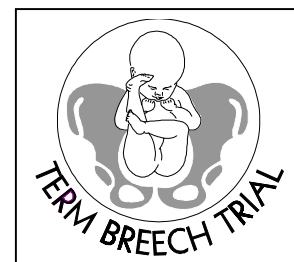
### Summary (as of March 1, 2002)
