Don't forget the Follow-up Collaborators Meeting planned for May 30-June 1, 2003.



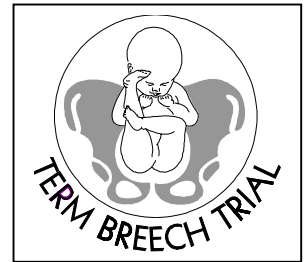
