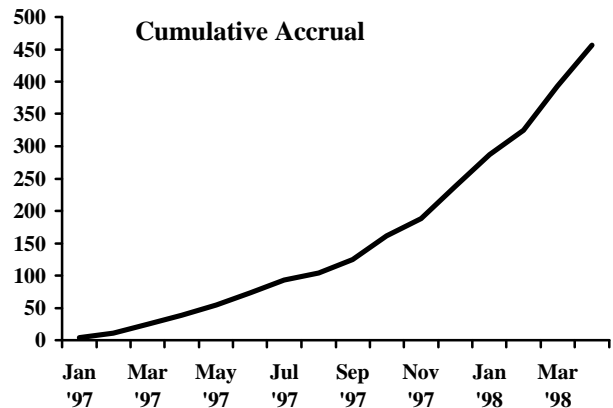

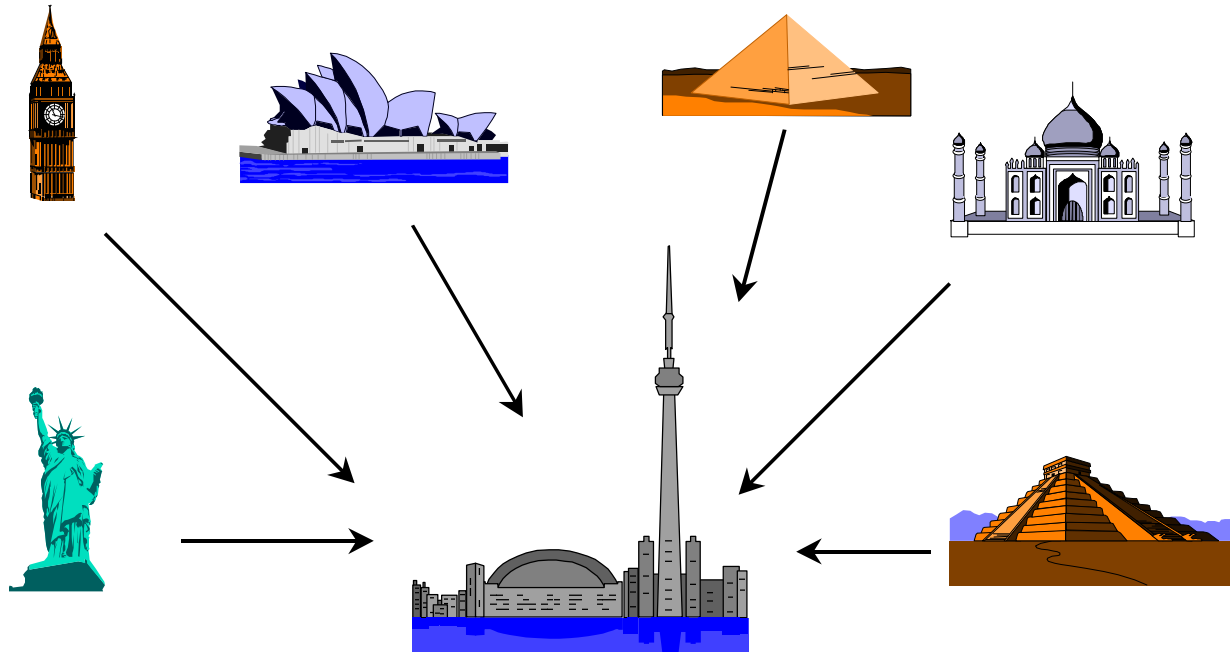

## Data Form Notes: a summary from past newsletters

*Please...*

do not send the *Neonatal* and *Maternal Complications* booklets back to the Data Coordinating Centre until after you have contacted the mother or her physician at 6 weeks postpartum;



be sure to obtain cord blood gases, especially base deficit, cord pH and  $\text{HCO}_3^-$ ;

do not record “hydrocele” in the *Neonatal* form (it is a minor congenital anomaly and does not need to be recorded for the trial);

enter the biparietal diameter measurement in question 2 of the *Entry* form, do not enter head circumference;

translate any comments that are written on the *3 Month Postpartum Questionnaire* if they are not in English;

complete the forms by **filling in** the circles - like this ●, not like this ☑
