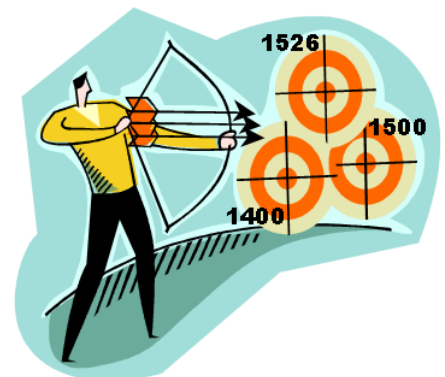

Please Keep Recruiting!

As many of you know, last fall we submitted a grant proposal to the Canadian Institutes of Health Research in order to secure additional funds to complete the EECV2 Trial. We are pleased to announce that we were successful and have been awarded the additional funds. One of the reviewers of the grant identified a small error that was made in the way we increased our sample size to deal with women who might be enrolled in the early ECV group but not get an ECV procedure. In order to correct this we will need to enroll an **additional 66 women for a new recruitment goal of 1526 women**. So... we are not quite as close to finishing the trial as we thought. We have adjusted our recruitment table on the second page to reflect this change and we hope we can count on you to continue with your excellent recruitment efforts for the EECV2 Trial.
