## Identifying Breech Babies - Some Strategies

Dr Marie-France Delisle has recruited 3 women since late December. She shared with us her strategy for identifying women with babies in breech presentation as they approach 33 weeks gestation.

So far she has used two basic approaches – the first is "word of mouth", telling all of her obstetrical colleagues that perform ECV about the study. The other strategy is to have the booking clerk call her when a non-study ECV is being booked. That way Dr Delisle can speak to the obstetricians performing that EVC about the study, so that they have it mind for



their future patients that fall within the eligibility criteria. So far it seems to be working! Thank you Dr Delisle for your dedication and enthusiasm!
