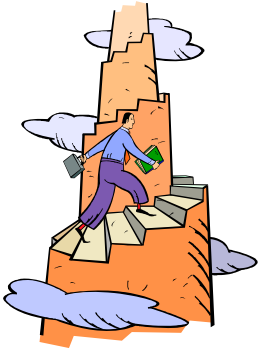

Please note that if the baby turns after the woman has been randomised, please complete all the forms as usual except the Procedure Form and Mother's ECV Questionnaire.

Data Campaign!

The second interim analysis has been completed and sent to our Data Safety Monitoring Board for review, so thank you to all of you who completed the data for the first 900 women recruited. We now need you to focus on completing the data for the final analysis of the trial! The faster we receive this data, the faster we can analyze it after recruitment has finished and answer the question of best timing for ECV.
