EECV2 TRIAL COORDINATION – NEW PLANS!



To allow for increased collaboration between MIRU and the University of British Columbia (UBC), where Eileen Hutton our Principal Investigator is situated, we are planning a new approach to the coordination of the Early ECV 2 Trial. This will involve UBC in the clinical coordination side of the study with MIRU continuing in its role as the Data Coordinating Centre (DCC).

The agreement is currently under review at UBC, and we will send it to you in the near future.
