


EECV2 Recruitment Graph




28-Day Follow-up...

The postpartum and neonatal outcome data for the mother and her infant can be collected immediately after discharge using the *Maternal* and *Neonatal Forms*. However, follow-up contact with the woman should be made at or after 28 days to confirm the health status of mother and baby. Any changes should be recorded on the data forms. If the data forms have already been forwarded to the Data Coordinating Centre, please contact the Data Coordinating Centre with the new information.
