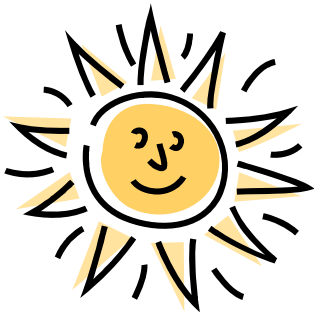

Data Reminders



Spontaneous Versions

Some of the women you randomise into the study will have a spontaneous version before their scheduled ECV procedure. If this should happen, please note that almost all the data forms should be returned including the *Labour & Birth Form*, *Maternal Form*, *Neonatal Form* and *Mother's Study Questionnaire*. Completing the first question on the *Labour & Birth Form* will tell us whether or not there was an ECV procedure, and if not, why. The *Procedure Form* and *Mother's ECV Questionnaire* are not required in these cases as no ECV procedure was performed.

Mother's Study Questionnaire

Please remember to ask women to complete the *Mother's Study Questionnaire (MSQ)* after they have delivered. If you haven't already done so, developing a strategy to ensure you receive the *MSQ*, such as having women complete them before discharge, is very helpful. Many of you have already been very successful at this, so our thanks and keep up the great work!
