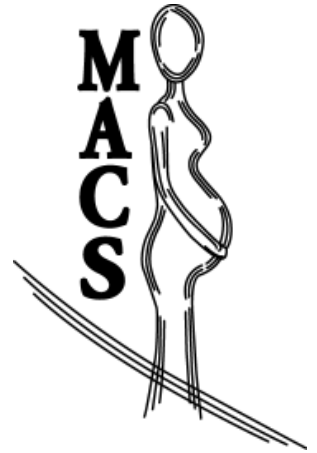

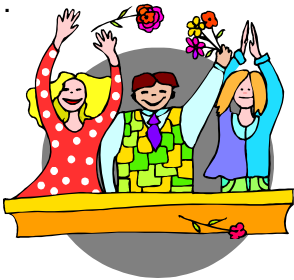

## Why is the recruitment period limited to 26<sup>0/7</sup> through 30<sup>6/7</sup> weeks gestational age?

This is the way in which the primary research question was defined, and the sample size calculated, to ensure that we are looking at a relatively high risk group. Although, based on discussions at the Collaborators' Meeting last fall, we increased the time over which the study drug can be given (up to 33<sup>6/7</sup> weeks), the eligible recruitment period remains the same.



## Why are there extra treatment number stickers in the study drug box?

Since it is so important that we have an accurate record of the treatment that is given to each MACS participant, we have provided treatment number stickers for each course of treatment inside the shrink-wrapped packets. In case any of these stickers get lost or damaged, we have included extras in each treatment box. You may want to store them in the patient file until they are needed.
