

The MACS team would like to welcome our 2 newest centres: North Bay General, North Bay, Canada and Peace Maternity Hospital, Shanghai, China.


SMFM Meeting:

The language of consent forms can sometimes be scary for moms-to-be and their families. A suggested method for use of the consent form is to first discuss the study with the mom and family, answer any questions that may arise and then once interest is established, the consent form should then be given.

When filling in dataforms, please remember to fill in "not done" when appropriate. The most commonly missed question is Question #12 (Neonatal Data Form): Did the baby have any head ultrasounds? If the baby did have head ultrasounds between day 1-7, please mark the number of ultrasounds done. If there were no ultrasounds done on days 8-14, please mark not done.
