

STUDY DRUG INFORMATION

As many of you will know, earlier this month we learned that there was a drug recall on a shipment of betamethasone that had been sent to some of our collaborating centres. The manufacturer of the drug has told us that the recall was due to a production problem and that there was no health risk. To date, there have been no adverse events reported in relation to this drug recall. Centres involved in the recall have been asked to return the affected cartons to our distributor and we are working hard to arrange for new supplies of study drug in order to continue recruitment. We expect the situation to be resolved in early August. *Our thanks to all of the involved centres for their patience and understanding.*




