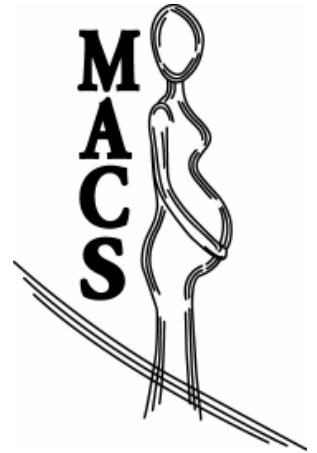

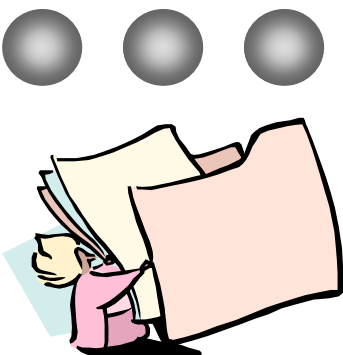

Do you have a unique way that you make women feel special for participating in MACS? If so, please share your ideas with us and we will publish them in upcoming newsletters.

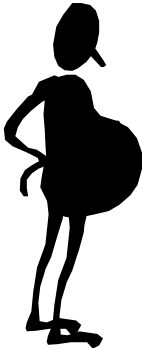

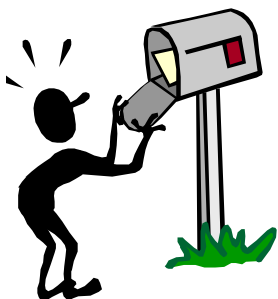
We will also be hosting a special meeting for coordinators to discuss data management issues.
