Encourage Pelvic Floor Exercises

"Pelvic floor muscle training during pregnancy and during the first few months postpartum has been shown to reduce the prevalence of postpartum incontinence. All women will therefore be encouraged to undertake pelvic floor muscle exercises and to continue them after delivery". TBS Protocol section 2.3.6.

Remember, it is important to maintain contact with your patients so that you will be able to locate them for the follow-up. Reminders to contact patients are sent every 3 months. Presentation at Delivery

Queries have been posed regarding questions 1 and 2 on the Delivery Form that record information about presentation and mode of delivery. For the Twin Birth Study, the presentation at delivery for either twin is considered to be: the presentation of the baby *as it is being delivered* in a *vaginal birth*, or the presentation of the baby *at uterine incision*, if it is delivered *by Caesarean section*.
