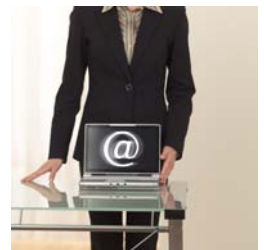

Patient Contact

1. Approach *all* eligible patients
2. Be involved with the patient's care:
 - Build a relationship with your patient
 - Encourage a feeling of support with each patient
3. Devote time to introduce and discuss TBS with each patient and ensure all questions are answered
4. Obtain patient referrals from other local hospitals and provide tokens of appreciation to those referring eligible patients

Summary of Recruitment Tips

(Continued from page 1)

Study Site Coordination

1. Maintain study presence by:
 - regularly presenting TBS at rounds
 - mentioning TBS at every departmental meeting
 - putting TBS labels on patient charts for all eligible women who are expecting twins
 - utilizing publicity to raise awareness
2. Plan routine contacts with regional site investigators to encourage recruitment
3. Established active centres can assist newly active centres by giving tips on starting recruitment
4. Host specialized twins clinics
5. Assign one or two people to be responsible for recruitment to maintain consistency
6. Study Coordinator should maintain regular contact after the initial meeting with the potential recruit
7. Study Coordinator should be accessible at all times
8. Declare TBS as the department's "policy" for management of twin pregnancies

This month we would like to introduce Dr Jim Thornton: **Dr Jim Thornton** from Nottingham reports that TBS recruitment in the UK seems to be picking up recently. This may be because of the new Comprehensive Clinical Research Network (CCRN) which allocates research support to centres in proportion to how many participants they recruit to approved studies like TBS. Over the next year, most if not all UK TBS centres will be receiving funding for dedicated research midwives for this purpose. Some are already in post. Hooray!

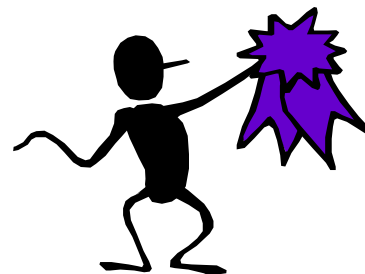

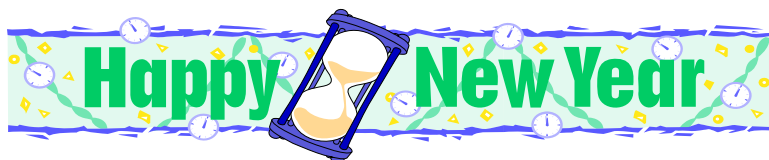
