Reminder: Inclusion Criteria

Please ensure that the following criteria are met prior to randomising patients in TBS:

- Women at $32^{0} 38^{6}$ weeks gestation 1. 2.
 - Estimated Fetal Weight of each fetus is 1500 4000 g
 - Both twins are alive at the time of randomisation
 - Twin A is in **cephalic** presentation
