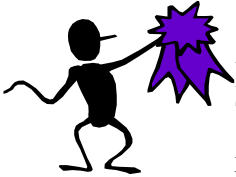

2 Year Follow-up Tip

The Clinical Neurodevelopmental Assessment Form (CNA) is only needed if a child scores below the cutoff in one or more areas of the ASQ, or if the ASQ was completed outside the appropriate window. If a child scores well, and the ASQ is completed within the appropriate date window, a CNA is not needed.

The date window for completing the ASQ is based on the child's age and is corrected for children who were born before 37 weeks. We provide the appropriate window for each child on the *Due for Follow-up* notices so that you will know when the ASQ should be completed. Be sure to copy this information to the ASQ cover before sending the forms to the mother for completion.
