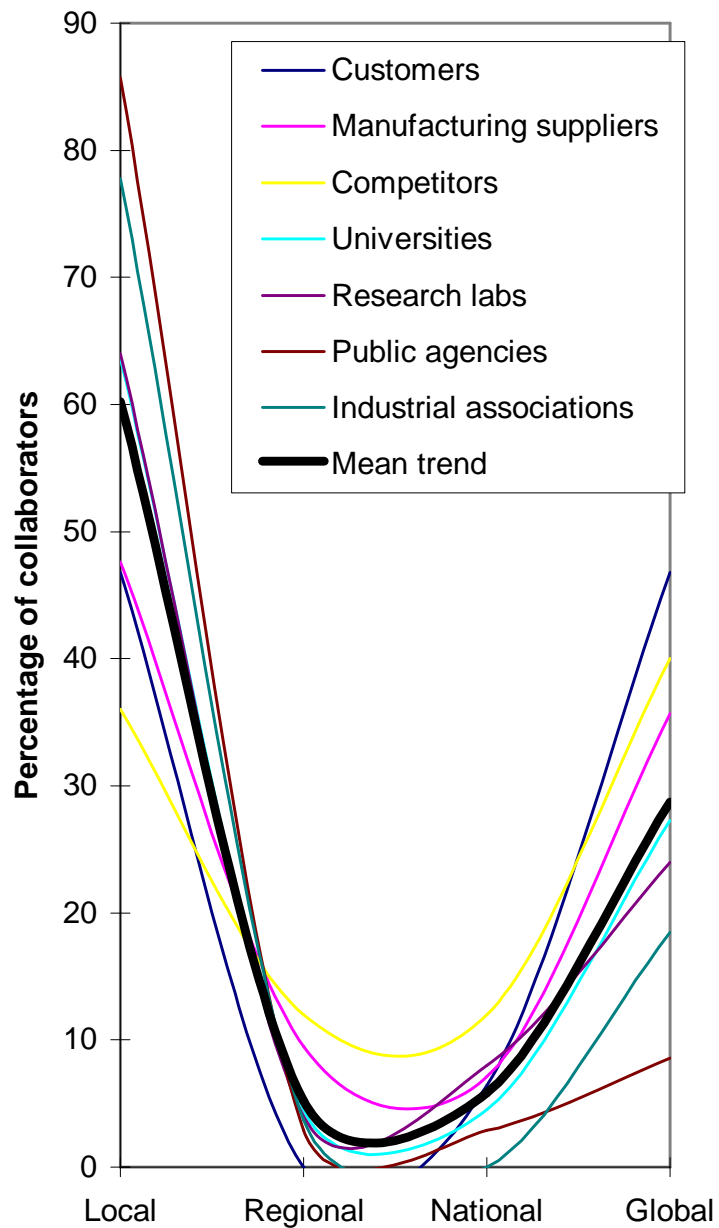
First Paper

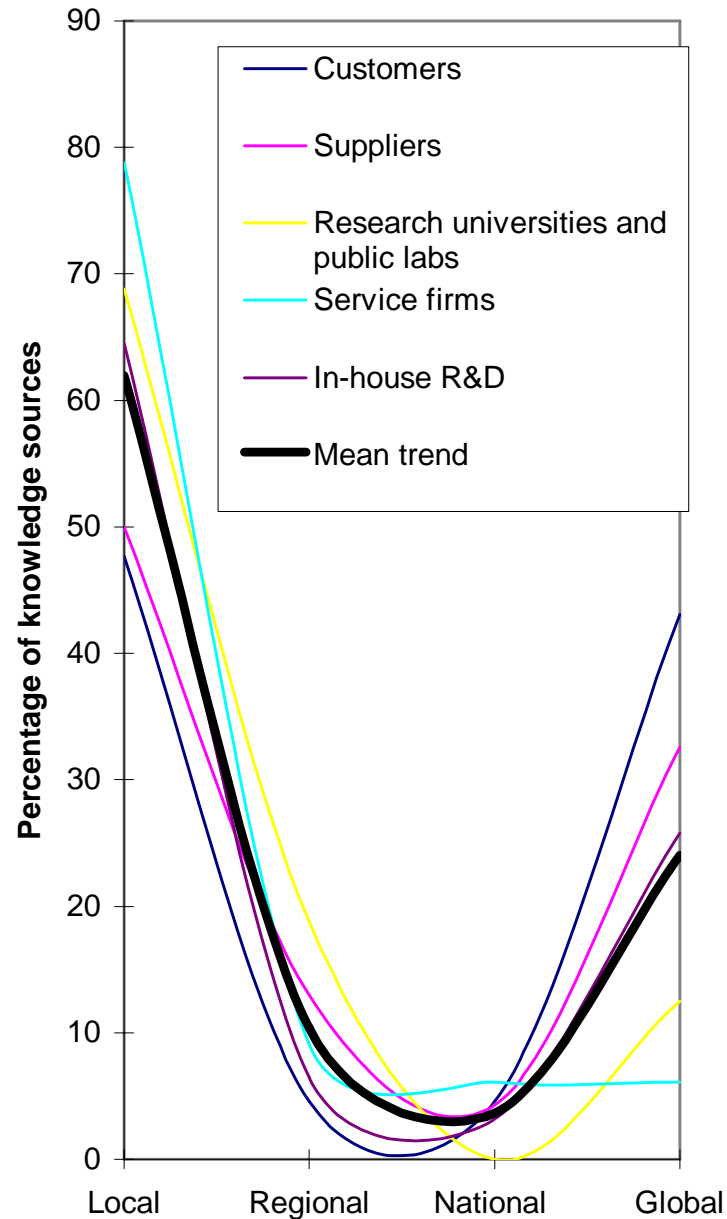

- Cluster or Urban region?

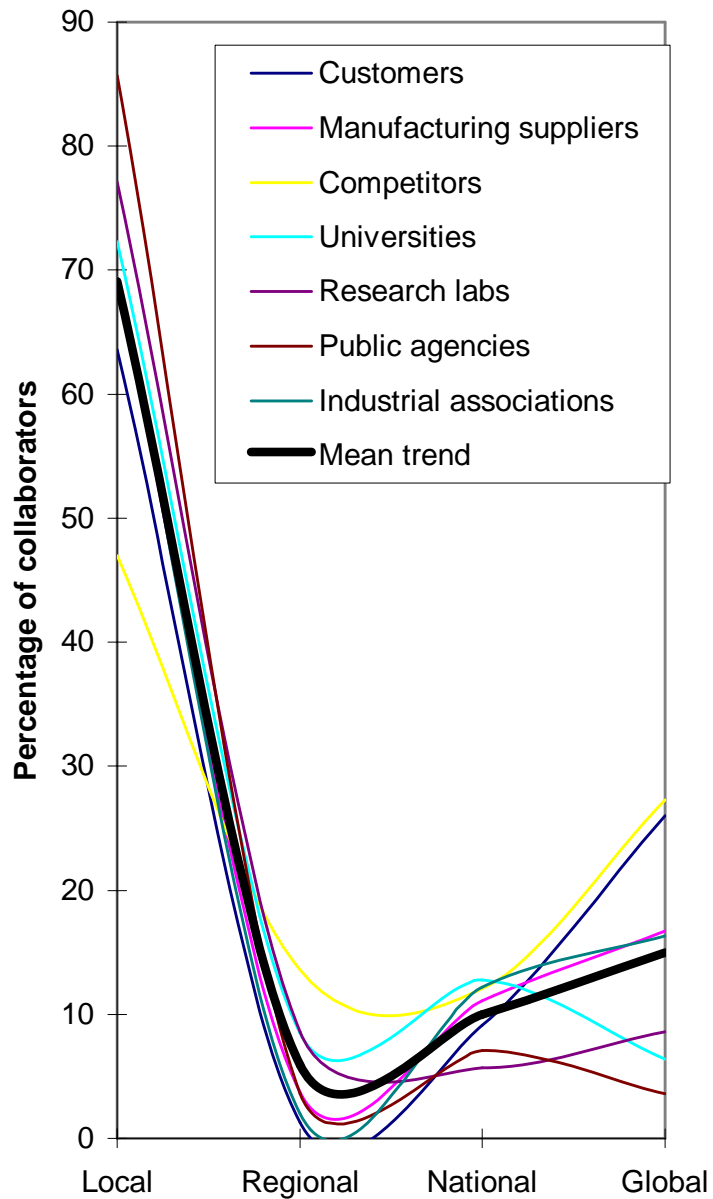

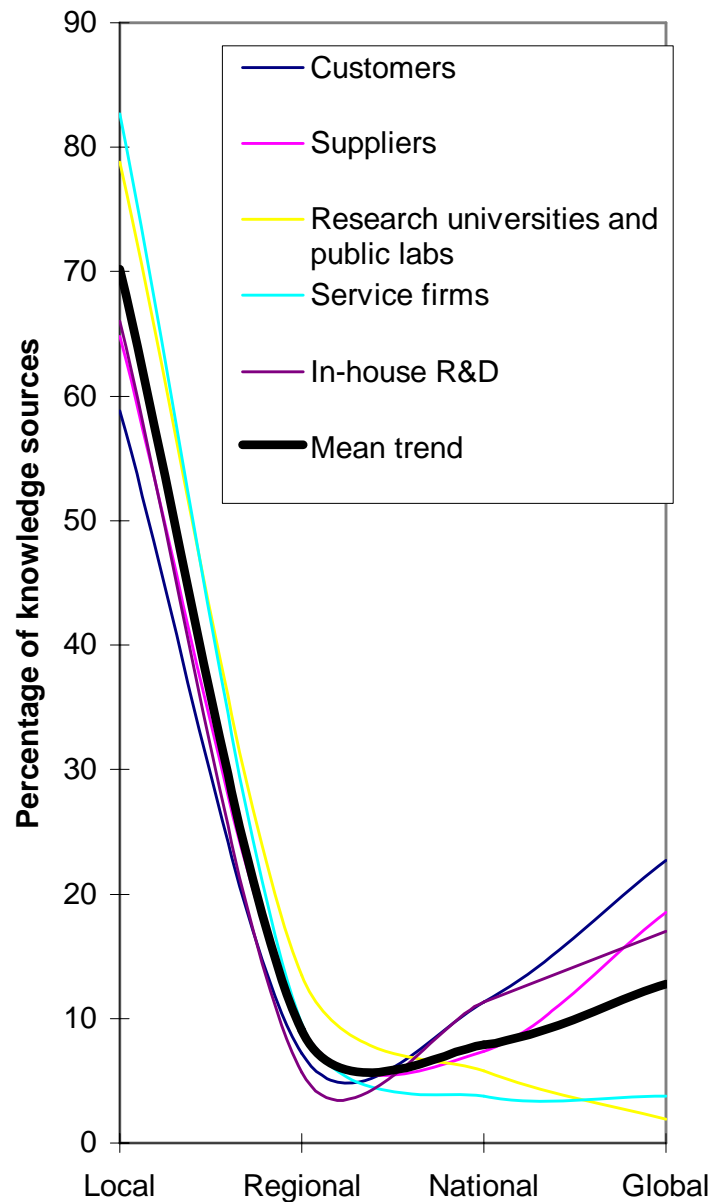
HMTM Knowledge Sources
